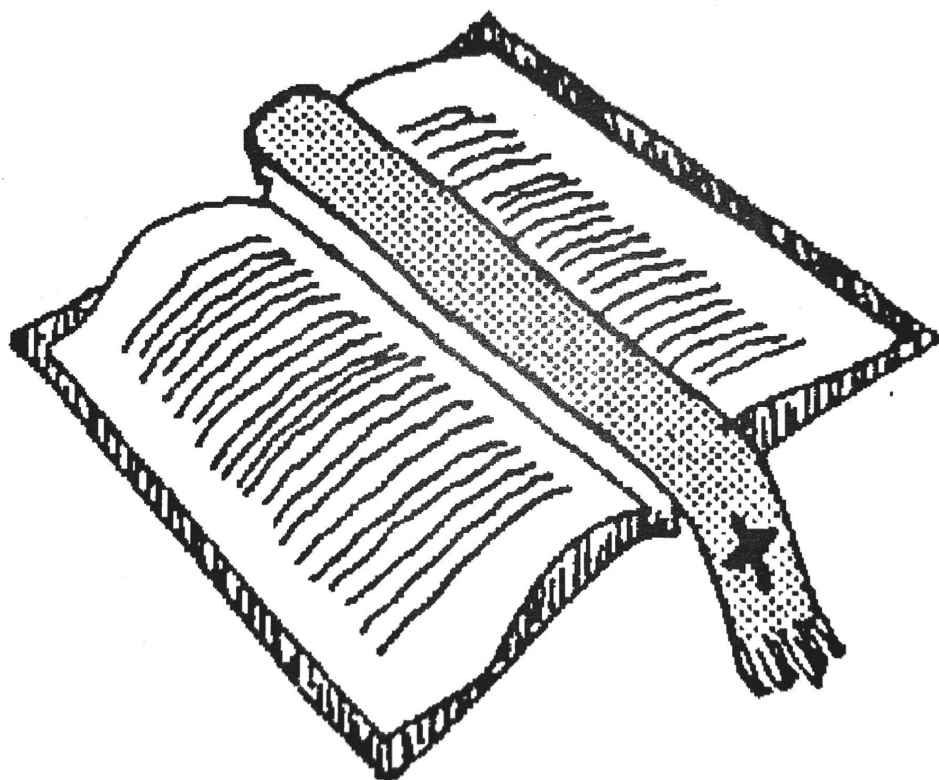


Evening Service

Reader:
